

MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

Defendant Matthew DeHart, through counsel, moves this Court for an order continuing the hearing currently set in this matter on April 14, 2015 to a date after May 8, 2015, convenient to the Court's calendar. In support, defendant would show:

1. On February 23, 2015, *pro bono* counsel of record, Tor Ekeland, filed a Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* (Docket No. 215). On April 8, 2015, Frederic Jennings filed a Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* (Docket No. 228). A hearing on the motions is currently set for April 14, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. (Docket No. 225).

2. Defendant recently returned to the Middle District of Tennessee and is currently housed in the Warren County Regional Jail in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Undersigned counsel has met with the defendant and Tor Ekeland and Frederick Jennings at length, and all parties agree that additional time is necessary to further discuss and resolve representation issues and defense strategies prior to a hearing in this matter.

3. AUSA Ingram has informed the government does not oppose defendant's motion for a continuance.
